Minutes of an extraordinary meeting of Newton Parish Council held on Wednesday 25th May 2016 at 7.30 p.m. in Newton Village Hall

4. Street lighting

JH submitted tenders from WCC, Hi'lite and Eon for replacement LED street lights for the whole village. It was agreed the order be placed with Eon for a price of £14,466 inc vat and the vat can be reclaimed. The electric bill should reduce to £180 a year saving approx £500 a year. As they come with a 2 year warranty there should be no service charge on them for 2 years. JH agreed to liaise with Eon and give the go ahead. He was thanked for all his work producing the quotes.

5. P. Morris-Jones had sent DC the new bus timetable. There are only 4 buses from Newton to Rugby and 2 buses from Rugby to Newton per day. DC highlighted that the planning application for 40 houses opposite The Leys had been based on the more regular bus service that had been in place. The Leicester bus was now going along the Leicester Road to Elliotts Field and not through Newton. It was agreed DC would contact the Planning Officer Nathan Loud pointing out this does not honour what was agreed with regards the planning application. A copy to R. Hughes.
