**NOTIFICATION OF ESSENTIAL SAFETY MAINTENANCE WORKS
M6 Junction 1 to M1 Junction 19 Northbound and Southbound Carriageways.**

I'm writing to let you know that we'll be carrying out essential maintenance work on the M6 between the M1 Junction 19 and the M6 Junction 1 on both the northbound and southbound carriageways, including the exit / entry slip roads.

During our comprehensive scheme of work, we'll repair and replace damaged drains, resurface the carriageway, renew damaged kerbs, refresh road markings and install road studs.

Once completed, all road users will benefit from improved road safety and a smoother driving experience.

When will the work take place?

Work is due to start **27 September 2021** and is scheduled for completion by the end of **January 2022**.

To keep our programme for these works as short as possible and minimise disruption to the local community, we will work:

- between 9pm and 6am Monday to Sunday.

Please note that all our planned works are subject to change due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances, such as emergency roadworks becoming necessary on the diversion route.

How will the work affect traffic?

To maintain a safe environment for our workforce and motorists, we will need to fully close the carriageway while we work.

During all road closures we'll put in place fully signed diversion routes which have been agreed with the Local Authority. All carriageways will be open as usual outside our working hours.

If you'd like more information about the different phases of our work or a copy of the diversion route drawings, please feel free to get in touch with us.

How will the work affect businesses and residents?

We'll make sure that access to businesses and residences is maintained wherever possible.

Please be assured that all winter maintenance work i.e. gritting of the roads will be carried out as usual too.

We will also have a dedicated Public Liaison Officer on hand to answer any questions.
