Re: M6 northbound junction 1 to junction 2 routine maintenance

I'm writing to inform you of some upcoming maintenance work on M6, near Coventry. This work will be carried out on our behalf by our contractor, Kier.

What we're doing and why?

We'll be carrying out routine maintenance work to the carriageway on M6 between junction 1 and junction 2. The work has been identified following a recent inspection of this part of the network. The completed work will ensure we continue to provide a safer road to road users at all times.

When will this work take place?

Our work will start on 21 March 2022, and run through until 26 March 2022. We'll work overnight when traffic volumes are lower from 10pm to 6am, for 6 nights. To complete our work safely, we'll close M6 northbound between junction 1 and junction 2.

What does this mean for you

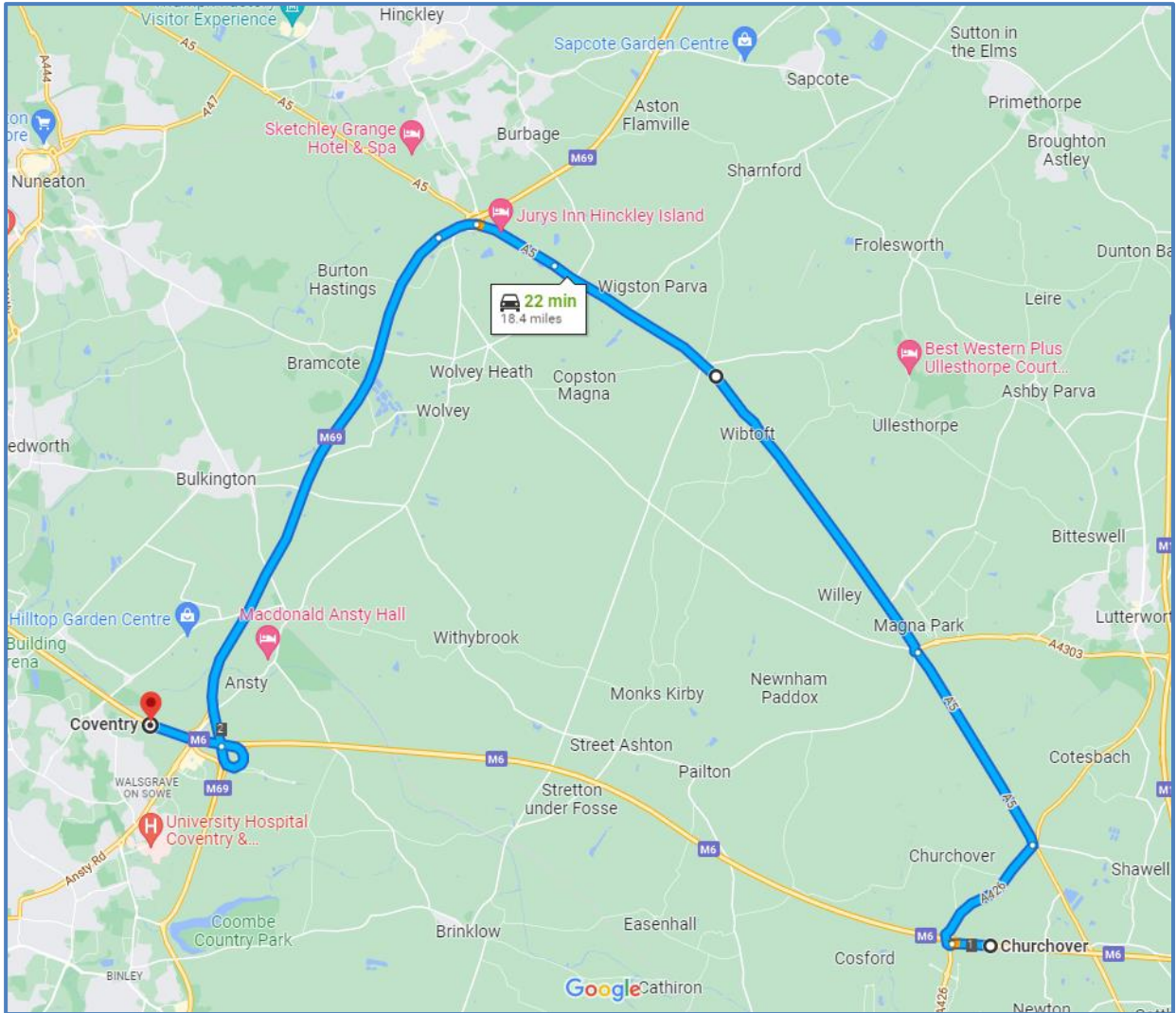
During closures, a fully signed diversion will be in place as below. Please allow additional time for your journey and plan ahead.

We'll make every effort to carefully manage noise and additional lighting whilst we work at this location to minimise the impact to local residents.

Our work is subject to change due to bad weather or any other unforeseen circumstances.

Access will be maintained throughout for the emergency services.

We'll make every effort to complete our work as quickly as possible, and reopen the carriageway as soon as it is safe to do so.
