This leaflet has been produced by Newton and Biggin Parish Council to provide information about organisations and facilities the village and surrounding area has to offer you. There is also a list of local contacts you may find helpful.

### **ACTIVITIES**

#### **Public Houses**

There are two public houses in the parish. The Stag and Pheasant on Main Street serves traditional pub food daily and periodically has 'themed evenings'. There is a pub quiz most Thursday evenings and music nights are organised through the year. Beer garden and dog friendly.

The St. Thomas Cross is situated on the junction of Newton Rd and Newton Manor Lane. It has a children's play area with BBQ and live bands play in the purpose-built shelter in the summer months. It also runs various pub games and sports teams.

#### **The Village Hall**

The Village Hall is situated in Silver Street and is used by the community for a variety of purposes including yoga, pottery and 'Live and Local' performances. The Hall has excellent facilities, which includes kitchen and Wi-Fi, and is available for your own use (residents rate) please contact Ruth Hughes on 01788 860725 for more information and booking.

#### **The Five Arches Wildlife Site**

This public site is located at the northern end of the Great Central Way footpath and cycleway and is accessed from the Newton picnic site car park. The site is managed by Butterfly Conservation in partnership with the Parish Council in the interest of improving biodiversity.

#### **Allotments**

Newton Townland Allotments are the second oldest in the country (founded 1757). They are located at the bottom of Little London Lane and are in popular demand. ### **PUBLIC SERVICES**

#### **Public Transport**

Arriva has a bus service which links Newton to Rugby. There are bus stops into town at the Leys and on Main Street opposite Silver Street. Return buses stop next to the Paddocks. Timetables are subject to change so check the timetable at the bus stops or on the Arriva Website.
